Haymes Aftercare Guide

Haymes Paint's high quality products will make your home come alive. Haymes Paint has been chosen for your home to ensure you receive the best possible paint finish. To ensure your walls continue to look great we have provided some simple aftercare tips.

Interior Paintwork

- Washing the wall surface: the surface should be washed down using warm water with a small amount of mild detergent using a soft lint free cloth. Soft actions should apply, do not rub vigorously. Wash the area with clean water and allow to dry.
- It is recommended that you do not use harsh abrasives, stiff scrubbing brushes or caustic preparations. These will polish the surface, resulting in permanent damage to the paint film which can only be rectified by repainting.
- In case there is an incidence of severe staining (like spilled food) clean the affected area immediately before the stain dries.

NOTE: Protect the coating against abrasive contact for 14 days. Do not leave detergent solution on surface for any longer than necessary

Woodwork Interior

For woodwork that has been finished with an enamel system or an acrylic system we recommend the following:

- Clean the surface using warm water with a small amount of mild detergent using a soft lint free cloth. Wash down the entire surface with warm clean water and allow to dry.

Regular cleaning will rejuvenate the surface coating.

Exterior Surfaces

To keep your investment looking its best throughout the years ahead, we recommend the following procedures to take place every six to twelve months:

- Make up a solution of mild detergent in warm water. Use a soft bristle brush or soft cloth to work on a section at a time and don't allow the solution to dry.
- Hose down thoroughly with clean water before moving on to the next section.

The above treatment will rejuvenate the surface coating and extend the service life by removing contaminants which can damage the surface.
